Your Fight Against ISIS

Story from Iraq

Earlier this year, a second container of meal packets was sent to northern Iraq. The food was packed with the help of hundreds of volunteers over a series of fall Packathons. A container with 276,480 meals, primarily beans and rice, was sent through one of our partners, World Help of Lynchburg, Virginia.

The container was loaded and driven to the port at Norfolk on November 16th, arrived in Turkey on December 19th, cleared Turkish customs, and was driven to the border with Iraq where it cleared Iraqi customs on February 1st. Our meal packets were taken to Baharka Refugee Camp near the northern city of Erbil. The camp is home to well over 100,000 people who have fled their homes due to ISIS. Many are Christians who lost nearly everything they owned.

Thanks to your prayers and support, the meal packets were distributed to 350 families in the camp through a Christian network on the ground. The families in Baharka are in need of the most basic supplies and, not surprisingly, are having a difficult time finding any type of work to earn an income. Specifically, 640 adults and 200 children received the food. Included were 70 elderly and 80 who were disabled.

A 37-year-old male and his family received our meal packets and they were very thankful: "We have to support our families but due to the current situation it is hard to do



this. We really are very grateful for each and everyone thinking about us and our needs".

World Help's partner on the ground has witnessed many breakthroughs ministering to both Christian and Muslim refugees. This has been a great encouragement to the believers, and **more than 200 Muslims have come to faith in Christ.**

The food you have provided is making a difference for the sake of the Gospel!



A Major Breakthrough in the Amazon

Story from Brazil

As you know, we are partnering with Jennifer "Jungle Jen" Foster and Stand Out Ministries to reach the unreached tribes of the Amazon in Brazil. To date, the Lord has used her to plant six churches among the tribes.

She has also launched a Bible initiative there called Operation Jose.

We share a common God-given vision to feed spiritual and physical hunger in the lost and needy.

On her most recent trip, Jen and her team took ten boxes of



our beans and rice meals, as well as funding from partners like you to purchase Portuguese Bibles once she got to Brazil. After a three-day riverboat journey, she arrived at her area of outreach. While there, she was invited to speak at a meeting of 15 tribal chiefs. Little did she know that many more chiefs would show up, as well as a couple of unexpected guests. There was great interest
